CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:35 by Marlene Vega, SYSL president

ROLL CALL: All present. Valley Hi hosted and introduced its Board.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by Land Park, seconded by West Sac. Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

No report.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

All Clubs wishing to host need to be in good standing. It is suggested that coaches take a year between taking different level courses but no longer mandatory. Contact Steve to host a clinic. Steve will also look into NSCAA coaching courses.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

At District Cup, referees were being checked to see if they were current. There is supposed to be a change in the Instructional Program. We are supposed to use different instructors. Referees need to have 5 hours of inservice very year. Ed is deciding on the Referees of the Year. If you think you have referees capable of doing Cup games, contact Ed. Most games will be local.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

Three Clubs still need to pay SYSL fees. If not paid, these clubs will be placed in Bad Standing.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

In March at the AGM, positions up for vote are President, Head Coach, and Head Referee.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

OLD BUSINESS:

We will need emails for all coaches and team contact for each team for the upcoming season. Will also need emails for referees.

Seeding - Bruce Mattos will put something together.

U6 passes. Discussion about whether needed for inhouse club play. Tabled until February.

SSA update - running Greenhaven and Land Park Metro/Select program. Last year 22 teams, this coming year anticipating around 30. Other Clubs can have Metro teams come join the SSA if they want to.

Bring in uniforms for approval in April. Clubs must stick to approved uniforms. Teams will run the risk of having their game cancelled for not being in approved uniform.

NEW BUSINESS:

529 teams in District Cup and there were many SYSL winners. 2nd half pins for first and second place were handed out.

GOOD OF GAME:

Three referees from SYSL are going to the Association Cup semifinals: Chad Reilly, Jessica Bowen, and Jamie Padilla, who was also named District Cup Female Referee of the Year.
