SYSL Board Meeting Tuesday November 8, 2011

CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:45 by Marlene Vega, SYSL president

ROLL CALL: All present. West Sac hosted and introduced its board.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by West Sac, seconded by Woodland. Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

Red cards were down this season. 6 reported, only one for a coach.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

All clinics are done for the year. 104 "F" clinic, 22 "E", and 18 GK (Goalkeeper) coaches completed the courses. Prepare to host clinics for 2012. Keep your coaches positive! Steve thanked all who hosted clinics and the managers for sending their coaches to these clinics.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

We've had complaints about some clubs not following the same rules, making up their own rules, etc... We really need to stress Inservices! For interested District Cup referees, send names to Larry Svetich.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

None – everybody's paid!

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

If any coach loses their coach or player passes, those players or coaches can't participate without them. No pass: no play or coach! Contact your registrars immediately so you can get new passes issued. November invoices will be out by the end of the week so that the balances can be paid by the end of the year. We had officially 7347 players this season in SYSL.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

East Sac will host the next meeting at the Coloma Community Center.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

The SYSL board has been out to games to observe the games, parents, coaches, and referees.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

District Cup applications are in. Most brackets are already filled. Schedules should be out by the last weekend of the regular league season.

OLD BUSINESS:

Our medals have been promised to be delivered by the Tuesday of the last league game. Soccerfest? Don't know if it still has openings. Check it out online.

NEW BUSINESS:

Uniforms. Everyone has to be in complete uniform assigned to that club.

Rule change to Goalie substitution: there no longer is a yellow card/indirect free kick awarded if referee not notified (as in a halftime switch). It is now just a regular substitution.

Mark Bearer has stepped down as Greenhaven Club Manager. Shane Singh has stepped back in.

GOOD OF GAME:

Becky from Clarksburg thanked Greenhaven for helping them get referees. She also announced that she is stepping down after this year.
