HEAD COACH REPORT:

Steve, after serving 11 years in this position, will hand it off to Mike Canti who will run for the one year temporary position to fill it. We are scheduling clinics for the new year and as of now have an "E" clinic set for Greenhaven and an "F" clinic in River Park

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:
