

# **SYSL Board of Manager's Meeting**

Tuesday, January 9, 2007

## **CALL TO ORDER:**

Meeting called to order at 7:37 p.m.

#### **ROLL CALL:**

Head Coach, Steve Martinez, was not present. All clubs represented except: Land Park

## **VISITORS:**

River Park Board of Directors.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Minutes not available for November, but will be posted and voted on in February.

## **FIRST VICE REPORT:**

Sarah Najarro reported that there are some suspensions that will rollover from last season as well as for District Cup.

## **HEAD COACH REPORT:**

Steve Martinez was not present.

## **HEAD REFEREE REPORT:**

Don Spicklemeir reported that the immediate need is to get prospective Metro coaches certified as referees. The first clinic will be held in Greenhaven on January 16, 18, 23, and 25, 2007 from 6-10 p.m.

There will only be 30 seats available for this clinic and there are currently 14 people registered. If you have a coach that would like to enroll please have them contact Don directly. He can be reached at 916-457-7969.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT:

Hope Anaya provided copies of the report. Report includes both November and December 2006 data.

## **METRO REPORT:**

Sarah Najarro reported that May 24, 2007 will be a mandatory Coaches meeting. Applications must be filled out with all necessary documentation proving referee

certification is complete and coach's license status must be attached that evening or the application will NOT be accepted. Coach must have an "E" license and assistant coach must have an "F" license. You cannot be a coach for one team and an assistant coach for another. Copies of the coach's license can be requested from the CYSA website (www.cysa.com).

## **REGISTRAR'S REPORT:**

Jennifer Neuner reported that invoices for registration were sent to the registrars in November 2006. Parkway, East Sacramento, Southgate, West Sacramento, and Greenhaven still have outstanding balances.

Registration policies were also provided so Club Managers would have the opportunity to review and provide feedback and/or requested changes. Those changes will need to be brought to the board for approval. Recommended changes should be emailed to Jennifer at soccercrazymom1028@hotmail.com.

## **SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

Next meeting will be hosted by Tahoe Park on February 13, 2007. Location will be provided soon.

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Marlene Vega reported that the CYSA Annual General meeting will be held February  $10^{th}$  and  $11^{th}$ . With voting on the  $11^{th}$ . Coaches, club managers and board members all have votes. Beneficial for all of the clubs to participate. Fee increase proposed for \$1.25 per player. Cost of insurance administrative paperwork re: registration, and evaluate and propose an online registration option and cost. Per player cost is currently 11:25 per player 12:50 and it will be 21.50 passed onto the clubs. League fees are brought to this club in April. League fees are not anticipated this year so this is the only fee that would be passed on.

Michelle reported that one thing that will affect everyone is that the insurance company that we have will no longer carry leagues on their Directors and Officers policies. Current cost is roughly \$380 a year. This would cover your club from potential lawsuits.

Item would likely be placed in the April budget report and would need to be considered for approval at that time. Michelle will research the options and report back.

## **COMMITTEE REPORT:**

Michelle reported that winner and runner-up pins we sent out prior to Christmas. Only one change was made to the standings and the season ended on a positive note. If you have teams that change to Metro status will need to remain as a Metro team and will not for any reason be allowed to move to a class 4 - recreation team status.

Pins for 2007 will be designed by Woodland and designs should be brought to the SYSL Board by the May 2007 board meeting. The company will provide samples upon request.

Requirements include the capital building, soccer ball and year. Optionally the designing team may incorporate their club colors.

All park field requests should be submitted to Michelle ASAP.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

Top Soccer is currently running out of Placer. Anyone is able to participate. In addition, any person wishing to coordinate this within their league can contact TOP Soccer. The Top Soccer information can be found on the CYSA website.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Marlene reported that any changes of uniform, design or color, must be presented to and approved by the SYSL Board. Club Managers should bring in a sample of their uniforms in April for review.

Several teams applied to play in Founders Cup but were not approved and have been wait-listed because paperwork and/or entry fees were missing or they were submitted after the deadline. All coaches have been contacted by the tournament coordinator.

The tournament list is available on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Metro Coaches should be prepared to apply immediately following the release of the list as they fill up quickly.

## **GOOD OF GAME:**

The all-weather soccer field at Granite Park is complete. This field is equipped with lights.

The Sac United U16 girls team won the Irvine Harvest Cup.

Sac United is hosting free clinics at the Panell Community Center. These clinics are available for children ages 5-10 year old.

Conlin Park will become equipped with lighting sometime this summer or spring.

Annual General meeting will be held in March for President, Registrar, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice-Presidents are up for election.
