SYSL Board Meeting

Tuesday, November 10, 2009

CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:40 by Marlene Vega, SYSL President

ROLL CALL: All present except OLG and River Park. Valley Hi hosted and introduced the board members present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by Land Park, seconded by West Sac. Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

Clubs need to call Sarah Najarro about Rec. red cards by Sunday to give her a heads up. Metro and CPL had lots of red cards. If a red card is given in Metro or CPL, it goes to Larry Svetich. Recreational red cards go to Sarah. OLG, West Sac, Woodland, and Land Park for PAD on Thursday.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

Coach of the Year nominations need to get into Steve. He will get new coaching clinics going for 2010.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

District Cup is coming up. Do not sign up your best referees to do lines. Get their names to Ed Foster to do centers. There are no new referee classes until February or March of 2010. There were five entry level classes last year and 130 new referees. We also had five Inservices and 133 refs attended. Referee of the Year awards, no nominations yet – get names to Ed. Clarification from last months meeting: for u6 and u8 when they are run inhouse, they do NOT need to be certified. All other referees need to be wearing their 2009 or 2010 badges. 2008 is no longer valid.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

There are 7687 players registered as of today. Invoices for all clubs will be going out at the end of the month. When Rec. teams apply for Cup play, they need to get a "Goldenrod" from Jennifer and District Six. Watch roster deadlines for Cup play.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Greenhaven will host the next meeting at the Elk's Club.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

For District Cup, SYSL submitted 80 teams and approximately 38 for Soccerfest. District Cup still needs two u10 Rec. teams. The new District 6 Commissioner is Mark Dickerson from Elk Grove. "Be kind to your referees". We are having ongoing problems with coaches and parents verbally abusing the referees.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

For District Cup, teams that are hosting, make sure that you have nets and flags in place 45 minutes prior to the first game. Have your fields mowed and lined by the Wednesday prior. There is a good chance that all District Cup final games will be in Woodland.
