CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:40 by Marlene Vega, SYSL president

ROLL CALL: All present. Valley Hi hosted and introduced its board. Guests: Kirk McCrary from Wilson Trophy talked about end of year pins/medals/trophies, etc...

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by West Sac, seconded by River Park. Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

PAD reps...meeting at Round Table in West Sac at 6:30. PAD reps need to call on Wed. to see if meeting for that week.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

The upcoming "F" clinic in Fruitridge still has openings. This Friday 6-9 and Sunday 7-2. The just completed GK (Goalkeeper) clinic had 18 coaches. Start thinking about Coach of the Year nominations. (Look on website on Coach's link section.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

Sarah attended a referee coordinator's meeting. The State is down 1000 refs and District 6 is short 300. CCSL games require 2 game cards printed out by the home team. One the referee returns and the other he keeps.

U10 Rec games are played 8 v8. Check SYSL bylaws.

It is necessary for Clubs to host in-service clinics to keep referees up to date. For Inservices contact Larry Svetich.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Some Clubs still owe SYSL dues.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

Only 1 team did not have player passes for the first week of the season. One solid month of laminating. Kudos to East Sac for always doing a great job. For transfer players, after lamination it will cost \$10, after September 1, \$25.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Fruitridge will host the next meeting at the Fruitridge Community Center.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

From the District 6 meeting: Tournament rules are different than league play. Please be sure to read the rules before going to a tournament so you know what is required. Every tournament is different.

Larry Svetich will be handling any send-offs. Changes to laws of the game – no slide tackles (check CYSA website).

For referee registration: If you miss deadline you have a grace period of one year before it is required to take the referee test. Must contact the District Referee and/or the League President for assistance. CNRA – after two years not renewing license, have to take another test.

TOP soccer – Check Elk Grove or El Dorado Hills. CCSL – Bruce Sillars – contact info on CYSA website.

CYSA fee issue – considering lowering Rec fees, raising CCSL.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

OLD BUSINESS:

Motion was made to do away with 1st and 2nd place pins at the end of the season (East Sac motioned, West Sac seconded). Vote 18-0-1. Motion carried. SYSL has about \$8000 to spend on pins. Kirk McCrary will research and come back with a proposal for a vote at the October meeting.

Motion was made by Greenhaven and seconded by Woodland to have individual Coaches report their own scores through TeamSideline and open the access for them to report scores. Club Standings reps can still monitor and adjust as necessary. Vote was 8-4-4. Motion Carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

School field costs could be going up by \$17-\$30 an hour. We need to find out more specific information about this and try to organize to fight against this.
