The first round will be on May 14 before and during the next Board of Managers Meeting in Greenhaven with the priority to be given for CCSL Coaches but other returning coaches and Board members can come as well.

Inter League Play – Natomas still interested in Interleague play but tabled until next month.

NEW BUSINESS:

After much discussion, Greenhaven motioned and Land Park seconded to allow Sacramento North Soccer Club to affiliate as a member of SYSL. Passed 15-0-4.
