CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:49

ROLL CALL:

Davis hosted and introduced its Board. All present except Clarksburg and InterYouth

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by Greenhaven, seconded by West Sac.

Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

There will not be a PAD committee meeting as there were no red cards during the first week of play. PAD will schedule as needed. Sarah will call.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

We had two free clinics in Greenhaven and Valley Hi with over 100 kids attending. The "F" clinic in Land Park was cancelled because there wasn't enough interest. There won't be another clinic until next spring.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

Immediately notify Bruce if there is a red card. Also make sure your referees know and understand the process for the send off and necessary paperwork.

At half time if a team is making a goal keeper change they are no longer required to notify the referee. However it's a good thing to do!

Referee evaluations and informal assessments will take place starting week 3.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

Jennifer got as many teams approved as she could. There are 4-5 teams still pending so they can play on the upcoming weekend. Clubs need to police coaches to get finger printed and players registered on time. We will have problems billing clubs for those who went to Live Scan off site.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

SoccerFest has begun online registration. Please promote. It will be held Saturday December 7, \$30 cost and for ages u8-u12. District Cup begins online registration in October. TOP soccer is still looking for coaches and hosts for its programs.

There are over 48,000 soccer players in the District, up from last year. SYSL has close to 7000 and is the second largest (to Placer)

COMMITTEE REPORT:

Rules Committee: We need to get the new rules posted to the website.

OLD BUSINESS:

Scheduling issues: No links to Coach on schedules – no phone # or email. Will be fixed.

There's also a glitch with reporting scores and receiving email notifications. John will adjust the process so that both coaches will be able to input, not just the Home Team coach. Clubs will have to let John know if there is a wrong score put in so that it can be corrected.

The six Natomas "DP" teams from Del Paso Heights may not be viable teams and John will have to adjust the schedules of the affected divisions accordingly. (Post note: all but the u10 boys team have been scrapped)

NEW BUSINESS:

A suggestion was made that SYSL put out an events Calendar/schedule to include things like coaching and referee clinics, training dates, etc...this was tabled to a later meeting.

GOOD OF GAME:

U. S. men beat Mexico 2-0 to qualify for the next World Cup.
