SYSL Board Meeting

Tuesday, October 14, 2014

CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:45

ROLL CALL:

Fruitridge hosted at Caballo Blanco. Absent: Clarksburg, Valley Hi

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by Land Park, seconded by Greenhaven.

Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

Only one red card so far this season in Rec.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

We still need a Head Coach! Nothing else to report.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

SYSL has the lowest amount of red cards in CCSL and CPL. Bruce has heard of players being sent off but no paperwork has been forwarded to him (send off report). Red cards shouldn't be pushed under the table. For red cards, the report, game card and player pass should be sent to Bruce.

We are short 600 referees in D6 at all levels. A number of refs have resigned due to referee abuse. Ideally we should pair up an experienced ref with a younger ref (though we realize it's difficult with referee shortage). Club managers should send out emails to referees and also to teams and parents reminding them of proper behavior.

If you have referees who might be interested in refereeing District Cup and Commissioners Cup, email names to Bruce.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

We are still missing payments from Clubs for Fingerprinting. Elizabeth will send out list as some coaches aren't identified by club.

Outstanding balances were discussed. Elizabeth is trying to get CYSA to forgive Tahoe Park's past due amount of \$6800. Valley Hi needs to make payments on this year's balance.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:
