CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:38

ROLL CALL:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

FIRST VICE REPORT:

No red cards first week of season in Rec.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

We still need a Head Coach! Nothing else to report.

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

Issues from first week: Tell your Head Referees to inform their referees to be courteous, respectful, and kind...to not come on too strong. Referees need to wear the proper uniform and their current patch. U14s will use three referee system and it's highly recommended for U12s too. U10 and U8 only need two. Visitors from CNRA should start showing up by Week 4.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

We are still missing payments from Clubs for Fingerprinting.

We are looking to get proposals from three different accountants/firms to handle our account.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

The last two weeks before the start of the season, there were still 50 teams that needed to be activated and player passes printed. These should be ready for Aug 1, NOT September 1! Suggestion was made that Clubs do their own batch laminations next year.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Tournaments: they are working on Scheduling. Let your Coaches know about Soccerfest. There is a new Substitution rule in effect in some of D6. You can substitute if the other team subs. This is not in effect for SYSL because not in our playing rules (but can be changed for next year)

COMMITTEE REPORT:

CCSL updates:

A Southgate team didn't register for CCSL and luckily they were able to make room for them in CPL. Clubs/teams need to follow rules and guidelines.

Seeding Committee/Scheduling

Each division is now setup to do auto coach scoring. Each coach is sent an email after the game to report their scores. This email contains a link that takes them to a page to input their scores. If they don't report the score, they are sent a second request 1 day after the first request. If they still haven't reported the score, they are sent a third request 1 day after the second request. If after the third request is sent and only one score is posted, the score will automatically be accepted one day later. As long as you have emails for your coaches, they will receive the auto coach scoring email.

Seeding/Scheduling

Cons:

Costs such as referees, field preparation, Enough fields? (69 needed based on last year's divisions u8-u14) August schedule conflicts with family vacations Some teams "sandbag" Referees? Paid or coach or parent volunteers

Pros:

Improves seeding process Reduces lopsided scores Provides basis for justifying placements Helps/assists new teams

Recommendation: Set up a committee headed by Ed from River Park to meet and come back with recommendations Also on committee: Jason (ES), Beth (GH), Cliff (LP), Manuel (FR), John (SYSL)

Parent Conduct/Player Conduct/Referee Abuse

1) Parent and child have to leave if asked by referee or coach

Recommendation: Tabled

2) Parents on same side, teams on opposite side – referee informs coach about parent

Recommendation: Tabled

3) Unruly parent or player – Fine \$50 for red card

Recommendation: Tabled

4) Yellow Card Tally and misbehaviors – 2 or more is a suspension...can we do this online?

Keep track of yellow cards on coaches by PAD Mark or hole punch on Coaches' pass for misbehavior Recommendation: Tabled
