### **HEAD COACH REPORT:**

Bruce's email read to BOM:

Please have a discussion about BLOW out scores. We still are having issues with unsporting scores with ALL clubs. Please try and have your teams observe the 7 goal differential rule. Coaches can teach many things, like, passing, position, through balls as well as give all players opportunities to play multiple positions. Its games like this that lead to players not wanting to play... we can stop this.....

Next – Referee abuse & dissent from coaches & parents. It's still happening and it's pretty volatile. Why? Why do we allow this behavior? Please remind your parents to SAY NOTHING to the referees and have positive encouragement for their players. A coach was sent off recently for questioning a call and the referee had a short fuse because the parents were very loud and obnoxious. Coaches – stay positive and complete the ref evaluation form for good and bad situations and get it to Mike !

Dogs - dogs are not allowed at our game fields. Please remind your parents of this. Yes Service dogs are always allowed – however they have to be away from the game field. Parents have been rude to referees and administrators that have asked them nicely to take their dog away from the field...

We need to have a discussion in Jan / Feb. about seeding for next year.

### **HEAD REFEREE REPORT:**

Referees have to watch the hand shake at the end of the game. That's where and when a lot of the problems occur.

Only use one language on the pitch as a referee. If someone asks the referee a question in Spanish, answer in English so that everyone understands.

The referee has the responsibility to quiet screaming, disrespectful parents. Tell the Coach to control them. Mike passed out a handout "One Whistle on the Field".

Yellow cards – ask referees to show them more often, especially after being warned earlier for same offense.

Mike should have a Referee Inservice early next year.

**TREASURER’S REPORT:**

We are hiring a bookkeeper for about \$900 a year. We will start getting statements in January. We are still looking for a treasurer!
