HEAD COACH REPORT:

No Pass, No Play. Referees need to check both teams in. Coaches need to have game balls inflated, nets and corner flags up, and fields lined.

The Coach has to fill out the paperwork. Referees are instructed to not let suspected player back into the game. There are two forms. One needs a signature and the other has a checklist of symptoms. For CPL/CCSL, the form comes with the player pass. The player doesn't get the pass back until Pete Zopfi signs off on it. The process is still in change mode.

There are changes in the Cup process, especially because of the birth year changes. Founder's Cup last weekend in October. There is a push for Rec teams to apply: u14, u16, and u19. U9 – u12 Founder's Cup second week in December at Cherry Island. Rest of the Cups are on normal schedule. The Older Cups are after the
